What exactly do we do at Care House?

Working together...

Care House works with law enforcement, child protective services and the prosecutor's office to reduce trauma for child victims of abuse by coordinating a forensic interview. A child need only disclose about his or her abuse one time, with one person, instead of multiple times in a number of unfamiliar and sometimes scary places.

Healing the pain...

Care House child victims and their families heal by providing a child friendly place for services, including forensic interviews, crisis counseling, child safety assessments, individual and group therapy, family advocacy and referrals to community resources. Child abuse is devastating. With the right kind of help, children and their families can heal and move on with their lives.

Stopping abuse...

Care House serves as the Designated Local Council for the Michigan Children's Trust Fund, offering child abuse prevention, education and training in the community. By educating parents and caregivers, we can empower them to protect their children, teach them how to recognize child abuse and inform them where to find help.

All Care House services are provided at <u>NO COST</u> to the families we serve.



Did you know **3/4 of victims** will not tell anyone about their abuse for at least one year. One reason why is because they do not think anyone will believe them.

Since 1996, Care House has conducted over 5,300 child forensic interviews and provided support services to over 7,500 families.

Care House is the only non-profit organization in Macomb county that provides a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary response to child sexual and physical abuse.

Care House coordinates over 400 interviews for suspect child victims of abuse, and provides services to over 500 families annually. All services are provided at no cost to the families we serve.
